Zone 1


- This carving represents a Haliaeetus leucocephalus that can be seen soaring above nearby rivers. Seek a location named for a president. You may want to salute as you pass by.
- Taller than an elf, with a much bigger nose, this elf-like creature likes to hide on the north side at this geographical location (41.621650,-93.666290).
- A member of the Caster genus sits in a yard down the street from "a" above.
- Our local mascot sits on a drive with a name that sounds like a Dickens character.

Zone 2

- This carving welcomes everyone to BVRDLE on ____dale.
- Leave it to beaver to solve this "zippy" equation: 50-31+10=__, 50-31+0=__, 50-3-1+1=__.
- This "beautiful" mascot can be seen running the blue oval and resides on XLVI Street.
- Oon't be crestfallen, just drive to find this pointy-hatted garden resident.
- Whoo, whoo lives on a pike named for a state?

Zone 3

- You might get confused between Place and Street, this one is in place and it's a hoot!
- When you find this one, you have gone to the dogs and he is called Franklin.
- On an avenue named after a dense growth of trees, you will find a wise nocturnal creature.
